*Update from Kirkbrae Country Club*

LINCOLN – As a result of the recent fire, and subsequent damages to our facilities, we have regrettably informed several guests we will not be able to accommodate their upcoming events at Kirkbrae Country Club.

We're working feverishly to utilize our network to find comparable venues with open dates to host our valued guests' special events.

“This has been a stressful and traumatic event for everyone involved, including our members, staff and event guests,” said Kirkbrae COO Mike Bradshaw. “We are still in the process of assessing the damage to the clubhouse before we can determine when we'll be able to open our doors in a safe and healthy manner. At this time, we're unable to guarantee those conditions will be obtained by at least the end of June.”

Unfortunately, a total of 14 weddings have been affected at this point. Our sales managers have been in contact with those valued guests and will continue to do so during this transition process.

“We have been in contact with the upcoming wedding parties and will continue to make every effort possible to help,” Bradshaw said. “We thanked them wholeheartedly for choosing us to host their special day and we are firmly committed to making sure they have a memorable and enjoyable wedding. It is a heartbreaking turn of events for all involved and we are fully invested in providing a comparable venue for the price they were quoted at Kirkbrae Country Club. As a small gesture, we’ve also informed our guests we are planning something special for them on their one-year anniversary.”

*Established in 1961, Kirkbrae’s current clubhouse was built in 2000, then renovated in 2008 and again 2020. The club is open year-round and operates seven days a week.
